TACCHO Public Health LEADer Award

Overview

The **Public Health LEADer Award** is presented annually to an outstanding employee within a Texas local public health department who has 5-15 years of public health experience and has demonstrated extraordinary performance with an exemplary commitment to local public health. As one of TACCHO's highest honors, this award is a means of expressing gratitude, recognition and encouragement of professional accomplishment in public health at the local level. This award assures a perpetual capability for recognizing achievements while urging current enterprise and new efforts.

Eligibility

This award is open only to active (dues-paying) members of TACCHO with 5-15 years of public health experience whose memberships are in good standing. If you are unsure of your membership status, contact Sharon Shaw at sshaw@taccho.org. All LHD staff are invited to submit a nomination to recognize the outstanding work in local public health by a LHD employee.

General Instructions

For your nomination to be considered, please follow the instructions below:

- The successful LHD staff person will be staff of a current, active (dues paying) member of TACCHO.
- Nominations must be typed or printed legibly.
- Selection will be based solely on the information contained in the nomination.
- Include pertinent facts and figures.
- Include as much about the candidate as possible. Remember, achievements you consider may not be obvious to the selection committee.
- Recipient will be notified six weeks in advance and the award will be presented during the annual TACCHO Public Health Conference in January.

Evaluation

- The selection process is handled by the ELT Committee on Awards, which consists of the
 Executive Director and appointed members of the ELT and based on the quality of the
 application and achievement(s) described.
- Award recipients will be notified 6 weeks in advance and will be recognized at the annual TACCHO Public Health Conference
